'Symposium on Powerful Teaching' attracts about 200 educators

Nov. 18, 2008

Approximately 200 area educators attended the annual Symposium on Powerful Teaching on Nov. 15 at Roane State Community College's Roane County campus.

The event for pre-kindergarten to grade 12 educators, pre-service teachers and technology coordinators included dozens of sessions on topics such as using technology in the classroom, "simple, fun science activities" and "21st century skills for secondary education."

Diane Ward, Roane State assistant professor of education, estimated that the turnout was about double the attendance from last year's symposium.

"We are very pleased with the growth of this event," Ward said. "In one day, educators can receive a great deal of information on a variety of topics. I want to thank the many people who contributed to this year's symposium. Without them, the event would not be possible."

The keynote speaker was Keith Young of Northeast State Technical Community College. Young is director of Northeast State at Elizabethton and assistant professor of reading.
